RESOLUTION NO. 26

RESOLUTION COMMENDING MARY GRACE TAN
AND KENNETH RAY AGUSTIN OF THE
PHILIPPINE PRACTICAL SHOOTING
ASSOCIATION (PPSA) FOR WINNING THE
GOLD (LADIES' DIVISION) AND THE BRONZE
(MEN'S OPEN JUNIOR), RESPECTIVELY, IN
THE EUROPEAN HANDGUN CHAMPIONSHIP
LEVEL 4 IN CHEVAL-BLANC, FRANCE

WHEREAS, the European Handgun Championship is a prestigious practical shooting event held every two years and participated in by more than 1,200 top shooter-competitors from 50 countries;

WHEREAS, the recently concluded European Handgun Championship was held at Cheval-Blanc, France last September 17-22, 2007;

WHEREAS, the Philippines was represented in this tournament by members of the Philippine Practical Shooting Association (PPSA);


WHEREAS, Mary Grace Tan and Kenneth Ray Agustin, both members of the PPSA delegation, won the gold in ladies' open and the bronze award in the Junior Category, respectively, in the European Handgun Championship, besting hundreds of other participants from 50 other countries and placing again the Philippines in the practical shooting world map: Now, therefore, be it

Resolved, as it is hereby resolved, That the Philippine Senate commends Mary Grace Tan and Kenneth Ray Agustin of the Philippine Practical Shooting Association for once again winning the Gold and the Bronze at the 2007 European Handgun Championship in Cheval-Blanc, France, thereby continuing and reaffirming the dominance of the Filipino shooters in international shooting competitions.
