RAMADAN


WHEREAS, Ramadan, which is the ninth month in the *Hijrah* or Islamic lunar calendar, is the holy month of fasting and spiritual renewal for Filipino Muslims and Muslims worldwide;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Congress has recognized the vital importance of Ramadan and *Eidul Fitr* through Republic Act No. 9177 which declared the first day of *Shawwal*, the tenth month of the Islamic calendar a national holiday for the observance of *Eidul Fitr*;

WHEREAS, this year's Ramadan begins around August 11 and culminates with the *Eidul Fitr* one month later: Now, therefore, be it


