RESOLUTION No. 61

RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE FILIPINO
ATHLETES WHO PARTICIPATED IN THE 6TH
ASIAN JUNIOR WUSHU CHAMPIONSHIPS
HELD LAST AUGUST 17 TO 21, 2011, IN
SHANGHAI, CHINA

WHEREAS, the Philippine Senate has traditionally paid tribute to outstanding Filipino athletes who have brought pride and glory to the country by participating and garnering awards in prestigious international sports competitions;

WHEREAS, the 6th Asian Youth Wushu Championships were held last August 17 to 21, 2011, in Shanghai, China, attracting a total of 419 participating athletes from 23 Asian countries;

WHEREAS, ten (10) athletes of the Wushu Federation of the Philippines headed by its President, Mr. Tan She Ling, and Team Manager Chan Cuan, took part in the various events in the sports competition and successfully attained for the country one (1) gold medal, one (1) silver medal, one (1) 4th place, three (3) 5th place, one (1) 6th place and one (1) 8th place;

WHEREAS, these athletes, whose efforts and discipline deserve commendation for bringing another triumph to the country, are an inspiration to all young and aspiring Filipino athletes training in various conditions to keep pursuing their dreams: Now, therefore, be it
