RESOLUTION CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING
MISS PHILIPPINES MEGAN LYNNE YOUNG FOR
WINNING THE CROWN AND TITLE OF MISS
WORLD 2013

WHEREAS, the 23-year-old Miss World bested 126 other beauty queens from around the world to become the successor of China's Wenxia Yu, Miss World 2012;


