1. **Senate Bill No. 163** - AN ACT STRENGTHENING REPUBLIC ACT NO. 8353, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE ANTI-RAPE ACT OF 1997, BY RAISING THE AGE OF SEXUAL CONSENT TO EIGHTEEN (18) YEARS OLD, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES (by Senator RISA HONTIVEROS)

2. **Senate Bill No. 305** - AN ACT INCREASING THE AGE FOR DETERMINING STATUTORY RAPE TO PROVIDE STRONGER PROTECTION FOR CHILDREN, AND AMENDING FOR THIS PURPOSE ACT NO. 3815, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE REVISED PENAL CODE, AS AMENDED BY REPUBLIC ACT 8353, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE ANTI-RAPE LAW OF 1997 (by Senator JUAN MIGUEL "MIGZ" F.
