RESOLUTION No. 119

RESOLUTION CONFERRING THE PHILIPPINE  
SENATE MEDAL OF EXCELLENCE TO 2020  
TOKYO OLYMPIC SILVER MEDALIST CARLO  
PAALAM

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 110 establishes the Philippine Senate Medal of Excellence in order to recognize, honor, and commend outstanding Filipinos, for their exemplary service, exceptional achievements, and invaluable contributions to nation-building;

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 110 provides that the Philippine Senate Medal of Excellence be conferred upon

Filipinos who are awarded an Olympic medal;

WHEREAS, born in Talakag, Bukidnon, Mr. Carlo Paalam won the silver medal in the men's flyweight boxing division at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics;

WHEREAS, prior to the Tokyo Olympics, Mr. Paalam won the gold medal at the Southeast Asian Games in 2019, Thailand International Boxing Tournament in 2018, 10th AIBA International Boxing Tournament in 2018, and at the ASTANA/President's Cup in 2017 and the bronze medal at the AIBA Youth Asian and World Championships in 2016 and at the Asian Games in 2018;

WHEREAS, the silver-medal performance of Mr. Paalam at the Tokyo Olympics helped achieve for the Philippines its most impressive performance since the country joined the Olympics in 1924. The Philippine team to the 2020 Tokyo Olympics garnered four medals, which now stands as the country's biggest medal haul since the 1932 Los Angeles Olympics where the country won three medals: Now, therefore, be it

*Resolved by the Senate, To confer as it is hereby confers, the Philippine Senate Medal of Excellence to Mr. Carlo Paalam for winning the silver medal in the men's flyweight boxing division at the 2020 Tokyo Olympics, thus bringing honor and prestige to the Republic of the Philippines and serving as inspiration to the Filipino people.*
