RESOLUTION No. 81

RESOLUTION EXPRESSING THE PROFOUND
SYMPATHY AND SINCERE CONDOLENCES OF
THE PHILIPPINE SENATE ON THE DEATH OF
METRO MANILA DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY
(MMDA) CHAIRPERSON DANILO LIM

WHEREAS, MMDA Chairperson and Retired General
Danilo "Danny" Lim passed away on January 6, 2021;

WHEREAS, his life was a life dedicated to the pursuit
of excellence – topping the entrance exam to the Philippine
Military Academy, and then also passing with flying colors
the entrance exam to the United States Military Academy
at West Point;

WHEREAS, General Lim was one of a handful of Filipinos who served in the Philippine military with a West Point degree, and was named commander of the elite Scout Rangers;

WHEREAS, General Lim's commitment to excellence is matched only by his patriotism, and he has been wounded twice in combat as commander of the forward Recon Unit of the 1st Infantry Division in Sulu;


WHEREAS, General Lim's patriotism is also articulated in his commitment to the path of social change, and while some might question the choices he has made at our country's various historical conjunctures, his deep and abiding love of country and desire for social change cannot be denied;

WHEREAS, across the political aisle, General Lim remained a towering figure – a man who fought the establishment, fought for the establishment, but always, no matter the cost, put country over self: Now, therefore, be it

Resolved, as it is hereby resolved, by the Senate of the Philippines, To express its profound sympathies and condolences on the death of the late General Danny Lim.

Resolved, further, That a copy of this Resolution be given to his bereaved family.
