## **Resolution No. 86**

WHEREAS, in recognition of her *ikat* weaving artistry, the National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA) named her as a recipient of the GAMABA or the National Living Treasure Award in 2016, which was formally awarded to her in October 2018;

WHEREAS, according to the NCCA, Yabing Masalon Dulo's peerless mastery of the B'laan Mabal Tabih is manifest in her impeccable work. For many years, Yabing Masalon Dulo has been a teacher and cultural elder among her kith and kin:

WHEREAS, the NCCA further stated that her exemplary oeuvre has brought pride to her community, animating the interest of many young B'laan in their remarkable cultural heritage:

WHEREAS, her commitment and dedication to preserve the Blaan traditional mabal tabih art of ikat weaving is an inspiration for many Filipino artists and her memory will always symbolize the rich culture of the Filipino people: Now, therefore. be it

Resolved, as it is hereby resolved by the Senate of the Philippines. To express its profound sympathy and sincere condolences on the death of Gawad sa Manlilikha ng Bayan Awardee Yabing Masalon Dulo.
