RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING THE  
OUTSTANDING WOMEN IN THE NATION'S  
SERVICE (TOWNS) 2022 AWARDEES

WHEREAS, The Outstanding Women in the Nation's Service (TOWNS) is a nationwide search conducted every three years by TOWNS Foundation, Inc. to identify outstanding Filipino women who, in their various capacities, serve as good role models and contribute significantly to the improvement of society;

WHEREAS, the TOWNS award has already been conferred to one hundred seventy-eight (178) outstanding Filipino women since 1974;




