

RESOLUTION

URGING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON GOVERNMENT CORPORATIONS AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES, AND OTHER APPROPRIATE COMMITTEES, TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE TRANSFER OF THE PHILIPPINE CHARITY SWEEPSTAKES OFFICE (PCSO) IN QUEZON CITY TO THE PHILIPPINE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION CENTER (PICC) IN MANILA.

WHEREAS, the present site of the Philippine Charity Sweepstakes Office along E. Rodriguez Sr., Ave., Quezon City, has much historical significance and more spacious for the performance of the various charitable projects of the PCSO;

WHEREAS, there are reasonable grounds to look into the allegations of the PCSO employees that their transfer from a spacious, secure and client-friendly environment to the PICC will be to the disadvantage of the general public;

WHEREAS, the transfer of the PCSO offices should consider the needs and requirements of various sectors affected by said decision;

WHEREAS, the PCSO rank-and-file employees themselves believe that this matter should be looked into as requested by them in their letter to some senators;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, That the Committee on Government Corporations and Public Enterprises, and other appropriate Committees, conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, on the propriety of the decision of the Philippine Charity Sweepstakes Office (PCSO) to transfer office to Philippine International Convention Center (PICC).
