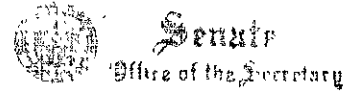


**RESOLUTION**  
**COMMENDING NASH ANGGAHAN FOR WINNING THE GRAND PRIZE IN**  
**THE SOUTHEAST ASIAN STUDENT DOCUMENTARY AWARD OF THE**  
**GOETHE INSTITUT**

*Whereas*, Nash Anggahan, a 25-year old graduate of the Polytechnic University of the Philippines, directed and produced a documentary entitled "*IskWater*," which won the grand prize in the Southeast Asian Student Documentary Award (SEADocs) in Bangkok, Thailand last December 1, 2010;

*Whereas*, *IskWater* is a short documentary film, focusing on the life of a woman who moved from Mindanao to Manila twenty (20) years ago and depicting the lives of the many Filipinos living in poverty near esteros;

*Whereas*, Anggahan competed with delegates from other ASEAN countries and emerged victorious amongst the twenty-five (25) entries in the competition;

*Whereas*, SEADocs, funded by the Goethe Institut in Thailand, is a competition encouraging the art of documentary filmmaking on pressing environmental issues;

*Whereas*, *IskWater* also illustrated the worsening conditions of the Pasig River, how it is affected by informal settlers, as well as its effects to the lives of people living within its boundaries;

*Whereas*, Anggahan's winning of the Award exemplifies the excellence of the Filipino youth and demonstrates their recognition and understanding of their responsibility to the environment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, as it is hereby resolved that the Senate commends Nash Anggahan for winning the grand prize in the Southeast Asian Documentary Award of the *Goethe Institut*.
