AN ACT
ESTABLISHING THE DIOSDADO P. MACAPAGAL MEMORIAL LIBRARY
AND MUSEUM

Be it enacted in the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in the Congress assembled:

1 **SECTION 1.** There is hereby established a library and museum in the
2 Municipality of Lubao, Province of Pampanga to be known as Diosdado P. Macapagal
3 Memorial Library and Museum.

5 **SECTION 2.** The Director of the National Library of the Philippines shall appoint
6 such personnel as may be necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act.

7 **SECTION 3.** The amount necessary for the operation and maintenance of the
8 Diosdado P. Macapagal Memorial Library and Museum shall be charged against the
9 current year's budget of The National Library of the Philippines. Thereafter, such amount
10 as may be necessary for its continued operation shall be included in the annual General
11 Appropriations Act.

12 **SECTION 4.** The Director of The National Library of the Philippines shall issue
13 rules and regulations that may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

14 **SECTION 5.** This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the
15 Official Gazette.
