

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

Carcar City is a 3<sup>rd</sup> class city in the province of Cebu. It was declared a city last July 7, 2007. It is famous for its delicious chicharon, ampao, bucarillo, pastillas, and other tasty delicacies.

The beautiful town of Carcar is rich in history and culture. A city with immense heritage structures dating back to the Spanish Era, a trip down Carcar City is like a trip back to old Cebu.

Well-preserved ancestral houses and buildings still line up the streets in Carcar. Carcar City was also christened as Little Marilcina of the Visayas because of its fast growing shoe industry that can rival that of well-established brands.

This bill seeks to declare July 7 of every year as a special nonworking holiday in Carcar City, Province of Cebu, to commemorate the day it was converted into a city.



**AN ACT DECLARING JULY 7 OF EVERY YEAR A SPECIAL NONWORKING  
PUBLIC HOLIDAY IN THE CITY OF CARCAR, PROVINCE OF CEBU TO  
BEKNOWN AS THE "CITY OF CARCAR CHARTER DAY"**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress  
assembled:*

**SECTION 1.** July 7 of every year is hereby declared to be a special nonworking public holiday in the City of Carcar, Province of Cebu to commemorate its founding day and to be known as the "City of Carcar Charter Day".

**SEC. 2.** This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
