## AN ACT DECLARING THE TWENTY NINTH OF SEPTEMBER OF EVERY YEAR AS A SPECIAL NONWORKING HOLIDAY IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF BACOOR, PROVINCE OF CAVITE IN CELEBRATION OF THE "ARAW NG BACOOR"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. In commemoration of the foundation of the Municipality of Bacoor, in the Province of Cavite, the Twenty-Ninth (29th) of September of every year is hereby declared as a "Special Nonworking Holiday" in the Municipality of Bacoor, Province of Cavite to be named as "Araw ng Bacoor";

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days upon its approval and its publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
