## AN ACT LIMITING THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE REGULAR MEMBERS OF THE IBC

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

**SECTION 1.** Declaration of Policy. - It is hereby declared the policy of the 2 State to enhance the independence of the judiciary by insulating it from political 3 pressure and influence, especially in the nomination and selection of appointees to the judiciary. 5

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SEC.2. Regular Members. - For purposes of this Act and pursuant to Section 8 (2), Article VIII of the 1987 Constitution, the following are the regular members of the Judicial and Bar Council, appointed by the President for a term of four years with the consent of the Commission on Appointments:

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- a. Representative of the Integrated Bar of the Philippines;
- b. Professor of Law;
- c. Retired Member of the Supreme Court; and
- d. Representative of the Private Sector.

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SEC.3. Limitation. - A regular member of the Judicial and Bar Council who has completed the service of his/her term of office shall no longer be eligible for re-appointment to the same position in whatever capacity.

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SEC.4. Separability Clause. - If any provision of this Act shall be declared void or unconstitutional, any other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

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SEC.5. Repealing Clause. - All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations, or parts thereof inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

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SEC.6. Effectivity. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in the Official Gazette or in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
