## "AN ACT

DECLARING APRIL 27 OF EVERY YEAR AS A SPECIAL NON-WORKING HOLIDAY THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY TO COMMEMORATE THE VICTORY OF LAPU-LAPU AND HIS MEN OVER THE SPANIARDS LED BY FERNANDO MAGALLANES IN THE HISTORIC BATTLE OF MACTAN ON APRIL 27, 1521, TO BE KNOWN AS LAPU-LAPU DAY OR ADLAW NI LAPU-LAPU, AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE SECTION 26, CHAPTER 7 OF OTHERWISE KNOWN AS THE EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 292, ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF 1987, AS AMENDED AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 Section 1. The twenty-seventh day of April of every year is hereby declared as
- 2 a special non-working holiday throughout the country to commemorate the victory of
- 3 Lapu-Lapu and his men over the Spaniards in the historic battle of Mactan on April
- 4 17, 1521 to be known as Lapu-Lapu Day or Adlaw ni Lapu-Lapu.

1	Section 3. All laws, presidential decrees, executive orders, rules and

3	Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

5	publication in at least two newspapers of general circulation.
