

## RESOLUTION

**COMMENDING RUBILEN "BINGKAY" AMIT FOR WINNING THE FIRST-  
 EVER WORLD WOMEN'S 10-BALL CHAMPIONSHIP, DEFEATING TWO-  
 TIME WORLD CHAMPION LIU SHIN-MEI OF CHINESE TAIPEI**

*Whereas*, the 1st Women's World 10-Ball championship 2009 was held at the Skydome Amphitheatre at SM North Edsa in Quezon City recently, participated in by forty eight (48) players from around the world;

*Whereas*, among the contenders in one of the biggest women's sporting events of the year were Great Britain's Kelly Fisher, Austria's Jasmin Ouschan, USA's Jeanette Lee, Guam's Shanelle Loraine, Korea's Yu Ram Cha, France's Latetia Dos Santos, and England's Allison Fisher;

*Whereas*, Rubilen Dacua Amit of Mandaue City represented the Philippines in the said event, along with 2008 WPBA (Women's Professional Billiards Association) Rookie of the Year Iris Ranola;


*Whereas*, Amit posted a 10-4 victory in the finals to snatch the title from two-time Women's World 9-Ball Champion Shin Mei Liu of Chinese Taipei;

*Whereas*, Amit placed second in the 2007 Women's World 9-Ball Championship and captured three gold medals at the Southeast Asian Games;

*Whereas*, Amit's victory puts her in the league of top Filipino billiard players and world titlists Efren Bata "The Magician" Reyes, Francisco "Django" Bustamante, Ronnie "Volcano" Alcano, Alex "The Lion" Pagulayan, and Dennis "Robocop" Orcollo: Now therefore be it

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, to commend Rubilen "Bingkay" Amit for winning the first-ever World Women's 10-Ball Championship, defeating two-time world champion Liu Shin-mei of Chinese Taipei.
