

**“AN ACT
DECLARING THE 25TH DAY OF JANUARY OF EVERY YEAR
AS A SPECIAL NONWORKING HOLIDAY IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF CARIGARA, PROVINCE OF LEYTE TO BE
KNOWN AS “MUNICIPAL FOUNDATION DAY”.**

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

SECTION 1. January 25 of each year is hereby declared a special nonworking holiday in the Municipality of Carigara, Province of Leyte to commemorate its foundation day and to be known as “Municipal Foundation Day”.

SEC. 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following the completion of its publication in a national newspaper of general circulation.
