Approval of this bill is earnestly sought.



AN ACT DECLARING DECEMBER 8 OF EVERY YEAR AS "MARIKINA CITY DAY" AND A SPECIAL NONWORKING HOLIDAY IN THE CITY OF MARIKINA

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress, assembled:

Section 1. December 8 of every year is hereby declared the "Marikina City Day" and a special nonworking holiday in the entire city of Marikina to commemorate its founding anniversary.

Section 2. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its complete publication in at least two (2) newspapers of national circulation.
