



AN ACT DECLARING NOVEMBER 20 OF EVERY YEAR AS NATIONAL CHILDREN'S DAY

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the "National Children's Day Act."
- 2 **SECTION 2.** November 20 of every year is hereby declared as the "National
- 3 Children's Day" to promote consciousness over the protection of the rights of
- 4 Filipino children and the importance of fostering their well-being to secure the
- 5 growth and development of society.
- This declaration shall likewise commemorate the United Nations
- 7 General Assembly Ratification of the Convention on the Rights of the Child
- 8 and in recognition of the United Nations celebration of Universal Children's
- 9 Day.
- 10 SECTION 3. Pursuant to the observance of the National Children's Day, an
- 11 annual program of activities shall be prepared and implemented with the
- 12 Department of Education (DepEd), Department of Social Welfare and

Section 9. Implementing Rules and Regulations. - The Department of Education (DepEd), Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and the Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA), in consultation with the Bureau of Internal Revenue, the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), and the Department of Interior and local Government (DILG) shall issue the implementing rules and regulations for the effective implementation of the provisions of this Act no later than sixty (60) days from the approval of this Act.

Section 10. Separability Clause. - Should any provision herein be declared unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of the other provisions of this Act.

Section 11.- Repealing Clause. - All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations or other issuances or parts inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.

Section 12. - Effectivity. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.

- The Department of Education (DepEd) shall facilitate and encourage

- 5 The Philippine Information Agency (PIA), in coordination with the DSWD,
- 6 DepEd, CHED, NYC and CWC shall ensure the effective information
- 7 dissemination of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in
- 9 at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation or in the Official Gazette.
