

RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING FARREL ELDRIAN WU FOR EMERGING AS THE INDIVIDUAL CHAMPION IN THE FOUR-DAY WORLD MATHEMATICS TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP HELD AT THE JIUHUA RESORT AND CONVENTION CENTER IN CHINA HELD FROM THE $2^{\rm ND}$ TO THE $6^{\rm TH}$ OF NOVEMBER 2011.

WHEREAS, the World Mathematics Team Championship is an annual international competition participated in by 65 teams representing different countries including the United States, China, the Philippines, South Korea, Malaysia, Indonesia, and Macau;

WHEREAS, Farrel Eldrian Wu is an 11-year-old Grade 6 pupil of the MGC New Life Christian Academy in Taguig City and is a part of the 47-member Philippine delegation that competed in the 2011 World Mathematics Team Championship;

WHEREAS, Farrel Eldrian Wu defeated 191 students from all over the world to emerge as the Individual Champion of the Primary Division in the four-day World Mathematics Team Championship held at the Jiuhua Resort and Convention Center in China from the 2nd to the 6th of November 2011;

WHEREAS, Besides Farrel Eldrian Wu, two other primary school pupils won gold in the individual contest, namely, Clyde Wesley Ang of Chiang Kai-Shek College, and Miguel Lorenzo Ildesa of the PAREF Westbridge School in Iloilo City;

WHEREAS, individual silver medals were also awarded to Andrea Jaba of the Saint Jude Catholic School and Sedrick Scott Keh of Xavier School in the primary division, and Ma. Czarina Angela Lao of Saint Jude Catholic School and Raenelle Ean Ngo of Chiang Kai-Shek College in the middle school division;

WHEREAS, bronze medals were also presented to John Aries Ceazar Hingan of San Beda College-Alabang, Jan Joshua Cruz of Pasig Catholic College; Christian Philip Gelera of the UP Integrated School, Matthew Angelo Isidro, Mikaela Uy, and Austin Chua of Saint Jude Catholic School, Shaquille Wyan Que of Grace Christian College; twin brothers Mark Christopher and Matthew Johann Uy, Aaron Dy and Aldrich Aldwin Mayoralgo of Xavier School, Karli Ang of the Philippine Institute of Quezon City, Michael Brodeth and Marc Patrick Celon of the Philippine Science High School-Main, Camille Dee of Immaculate Conception Academy, Brendon Go of British School of Manila, and Daniel Young of Jubilee Christian Academy;

WHEREAS, the Philippines Team I was declared second over all in the primary division team contest of said competition;

WHEREAS, the success of the Philippine delegation, which beat competitors from countries like the US and China, is an achievement that brings honor to the country and is a testament of our youth's excellence and competence in the field of mathematics;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that Farrel Eldrian Wu be congratulated and commended for emerging as the Individual Champion in the four-day World Mathematics Team Championship held at the Jiuhua Resort and Convention Center in China held from the 2nd to the 6th of November 2011.
