## RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE GRAND WINNERS OF THE 2011 NATIONAL SEARCH FOR SUSTAINABLE AND ECO-FRIENDLY SCHOOLS

Whereas, the promotion of this activity is the Philippines' initiative in support of the ASEAN Environmental Education Action Plan for 2008-2012 and the United Nations Decade of Education for Sustainable Development from 2005-2014;

Whereas, this year's grand winners are: Iliranan Elementary School in Negros Occidental, Camarines Sur National High School in Naga City and De La Salle University-Dasmariñas in Cavite;

Whereas, the grand winners served as inspiration among schools in their pursuit to be a green learning institution, where students become aware of their roles in protecting the environment;
