- AN ACT PROVIDING FOR STIFFER PENALTIES FOR CRIMES RELATING TO FIREARMS AND LIGHT WEAPONS, FURTHER AMENDING FOR THE PURPOSE PRESIDENTIAL DECREE NO. 1866, AS AMENDED, ENTITLED "CODIFYING THE LAWS ON ILLEGAL/UNLAWFUL POSSESSION, MANUFACTURE, DEALING IN, ACQUISITION OR DISPOSITION OF FIREARMS, AMMUNITION OR EXPLOSIVES OR INSTRUMENTS USED IN THE MANUFACTURE OF FIREARMS, AMMUNITION OR EXPLOSIVES, AND IMPOSING STIFFER PENALTIES FOR CERTAIN VIOLATIONS THEREOF, AND FOR RELEVANT PURPOSES"

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

1	SECTION 1. Section 1 of Presidential Decree No. 1866, as amended, is
2	hereby further amended to read as follows:
3	"SECTION 1. Unlawful Manufacture, Sale, Acquisition,
4	Disposition or Possession of Firearms, LIGHT WEAPONS or
5	Ammunition or Instruments Used or Intended to be Used in the

Manufacture of Firearms, LIGHT WEAPONS or Ammunition. -1 The penalty of *prision correccional* **RECLUSION TEMPORAL** in 2 3 its maximum period land a fine of not less than Fifteen thousand 4 pesos (P15,000) TO RECLUSION PERPETUA shall be imposed 5 upon any person who shall unlawfully [manufacture, deal in,] acquire[, dispose,] or possess any [low powered] firearm[,]. 6 such as rimfire handgun, .380 or .32 and other firearm of similar 7 8 firepower, part of firearm, ammunition, or machinery, tool or 9 instrument used or intended to be used in the manufacture of any firearm or ammunition: Provided. That no other crime was 10 11 committed.] THE TERM "FIREARM" REFERS TO ANY HANDHELD 12 OR PORTABLE WEAPON FROM WHICH ANY BULLET, BALL SHOT 13 OR MISSILE OR OTHER DEADLY PROJECTILE MAY BE 14 DISCHARGED BY MEANS OF EXPLOSION OR PERCUSSION OR 15 ANY INSTRUMENT OR IMPLEMENT WHICH CAN BE READILY 16 CONVERTED OR HAS BEEN CONVERTED TO BE CAPABLE OF 17 DOING THE SAME. THE TERM ALSO INCLUDES AUTOMATIC 18 RIFLES NOT EXCEEDING CALIBER 7.62 MM AND AIR, GAS OR 19 SPRING OPERATED PISTOLS OR RIFLES NOT CLASSIFIED AS TOYS BY THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (PNP) IN 20 21 COORDINATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF TRADE AND 22 INDUSTRY. THE BARREL OF ANY FIREARM SHALL BE 23 CONSIDERED AS A COMPLETE FIREARM.

24 "THE PENALTY OF RECLUSION PERPETUA SHALL BE
25 IMPOSED IF THREE (3) OR MORE FIREARMS ARE UNLAWFULLY
26 ACQUIRED OR POSSESSED.

27"The penalty of *reclusion perpetua* shall be28IMPOSED UPON ANY PERSON WHO SHALL UNLAWFULLY

ACOUIRE OR POSSESS A LIGHT WEAPON. THE TERM 'LIGHT 1 2 WEAPON' REFERS TO A WEAPON DESIGNED FOR USE BY 3 TWO (2) OR MORE PERSONS SERVING AS A CREW OR MAY BE 4 CARRIED AND USED BY A SINGLE PERSON WHICH SHALL 5 INCLUDE DRUM-FED AND BELT-FED SUBMACHINE, LIGHT AND 6 HEAVY MACHINE GUNS, HAND-HELD UNDER-BARREL AND 7 **MOUNTED GRENADE LAUNCHERS, PORTABLE ANTI-AIRCRAFT** 8 GUNS, PORTABLE ANTI-TANK GUNS, RECOILLESS RIFLES, 9 PORTABLE LAUNCHERS OF ANTI-TANK MISSILE AND ROCKET 10 SYSTEMS, PORTABLE LAUNCHERS OF ANTI-AIRCRAFT MISSILE 11 SYSTEMS, AND MORTARS OF A CALIBER OF LESS THAN ONE 12 HUNDRED (100) MILLIMETERS. A LIGHT WEAPON SHALL BE 13 LAWFULLY ACQUIRED OR POSSESSED EXCLUSIVELY BY THE 14 ARMED FORCES OF THE PHILIPPINES (AFP) OR THE PNP.

15 "IN ANY CASE, WHERE AN UNLICENSED FIREARM OR
16 LIGHT WEAPON IS CARRIED IN PARTS BY, OR IS OTHERWISE IN
17 THE POSSESSION OF TWO (2) OR MORE PERSONS, EACH AND
18 EVERY ONE OF THOSE PERSONS SHALL BE DEEMED IN
19 POSSESSION OF THE FIREARM OR LIGHT WEAPON.

20"WHEN ANY OF THE ARMS CARRIED BY A GROUP OF21THREE (3) OR MORE PERSONS IS AN UNLICENSED FIREARM OR22LIGHT WEAPON, IT SHALL BE PRESUMED THAT THE SAID23GROUP IS A CRIMINAL SYNDICATE, AND IN CASE THE GROUP24SHALL BE CONVICTED FOR VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE25PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT AND OTHER EXISTING LAWS, THE26PENALTY TO BE IMPOSED SHALL BE IN THE MAXIMUM PERIOD.

27 "The penalty of *prision mayor* in its minimum period [and
28 a fine of Thirty thousand pesos (P30,000)] TO *RECLUSION*29 *TEMPORAL* IN ITS MAXIMUM PERIOD shall be imposed [if the
30 firearm is classified as high powered firearm which includes
31 those with bores bigger in diameter than .38 caliber and .9

1 millimeter such as caliber .40, .41, .44, .45 and also lesser 2 calibered firearms but considered powerful such as caliber .357 3 and caliber .22 center-fire magnum and other firearms with firing 4 capability of full automatic and by burst of two or three; 5 Provided, however. That no other crime was committed by the person arrested.] UPON ANY PERSON WHO SHALL UNLAWFULLY 6 7 POSSESS OR ACOUIRE AMMUNITION FOR FIREARMS. THE TERM 8 'AMMUNITION' REFERS TO LOADED SHELLS FOR RIFLES. 9 MUSKETS, CARBINES, SHOTGUNS, REVOLVERS, PISTOLS AND 10 OTHER FIREARMS AND LIGHT WEAPONS FROM WHICH A 11 BULLET, BALL, SHOT, SHELL OR OTHER MISSILE MAY BE FIRED 12 BY MEANS OF GUNPOWDER OR EXPLOSIVES. IT ALSO INCLUDES 13 BLANK AMMUNITION, FUSES, PRIMERS, GRENADES, BOMBS AND 14 OTHERS LIKE MISSILES, WHETHER OR NOT IT CAN BE USED 15 WITH ARMS, AND ANY AMMUNITION CONTAINING, OR 16 DESIGNED OR ADAPTED TO CONTAIN ANY NUCLEAR. 17 BIOLOGICAL, RADIOLOGICAL, CHEMICAL OR EXPLOSIVE 18 MATERIALS, ANY NOXIOUS LIQUID AND GAS.

19"The penalty of reclusion temporal in its20MINIMUM PERIOD TO RECLUSION PERPETUA SHALL BE21IMPOSED UPON ANY PERSON WHO SHALL UNLAWFULLY22POSSESS OR ACQUIRE AMMUNITION FOR LIGHT WEAPONS.

23THE PENALTY OF PRISION CORRECCIONAL IN ITS24MAXIMUM PERIOD TO PRISION MAYOR IN ITS MINIMUM25PERIOD SHALL BE IMPOSED UPON ANY PERSON WHO26SHALL UNLAWFULLY ACQUIRE OR POSSESS MAJOR PARTS27OR COMPONENTS OF A FIREARM, LIGHT WEAPON OR28AMMUNITION.

29 "THE PENALTY OF RECLUSION PERPETUA SHALL BE
30 IMPOSED UPON ANY PERSON WHO SHALL UNLAWFULLY
31 ENGAGE IN THE MANUFACTURE, SALE OR DISPOSITION OF
32 FIREARMS, LIGHT WEAPONS OR AMMUNITION, COMPONENTS

1OR PARTS OF FIREARMS AND LIGHT WEAPONS AND2AMMUNITION.

3 "THE PENALTY OF PRISION CORRECCIONAL IN ITS
4 MINIMUM PERIOD TO PRISION MAYOR SHALL BE IMPOSED UPON
5 THE LABORERS OR WORKERS OF THE MANUFACTURING
6 COMPANY OR FIREARMS DEALER WHO SHALL KNOWINGLY
7 AND WILLINGLY PARTICIPATE IN ANY OF THE UNLAWFUL ACTS
8 MENTIONED IN THE PRECEDING PARAGRAPH,

9 "THE PENALTY OF RECLUSION TEMPORAL IN ITS 10 MAXIMUM TO RECLUSION PERPETUA SHALL BE IMPOSED UPON 11 SUCH LABORER, WORKER OR EMPLOYEE OF A LICENSED 12 FIREARMS MANUFACTURING COMPANY OR LICENSED 13 FIREARMS DEALER WHO SHALL UNLAWFULLY TAKE, SELL OR 14 OTHERWISE DISPOSE OF PARTS OF FIREARMS WHICH THE 15 COMPANY MANUFACTURES AND SELLS AND OTHER MATERIALS 16 USED BY THE COMPANY IN THE MANUFACTURE OR SALE OF 17 FIREARMS. THE BUYER OR THE POSSESSOR OF SUCH STOLEN 18 PARTS OR MATERIALS SHALL SUFFER THE SAME PENALTY AS 19 THE LABORER, WORKER OR EMPLOYEE.

20 "THE PENALTY OF PRISION MAYOR IN ITS MAXIMUM 21 PERIOD TO RECLUSION TEMPORAL AND A FINE OF ONE 22 HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (P100,000.00) SHALL BE IMPOSED 23 UPON ANY PERSON WHO SHALL UNLAWFULLY MANUFACTURE. 24 DEAL IN, ACQUIRE, DISPOSE OF OR POSSESS MACHINERY, 25 TOOLS OR INSTRUMENTS USED OR INTENDED TO BE USED IN 26 THE MANUFACTURE OF FIREARMS, LIGHT WEAPONS, PARTS 27 AND AMMUNITION.

28 "IF THE BUSINESS OR EMPLOYMENT DOES NOT 29 LAWFULLY DEAL WITH THE MANUFACTURE OF FIREARMS, 30 LIGHT WEAPONS OR AMMUNITION, THE POSSESSION OF ANY 31 MACHINERY. TOOL INSTRUMENT OR USED IN THE 32 MANUFACTURE OF FIREARMS, LIGHT WEAPONS, PARTS, 33 ACCESSORIES AND AMMUNITION SHALL BE PRIMA FACIE EVIDENCE THAT SUCH ARTICLE IS INTENDED TO BE USED IN THE UNLAWFUL OR ILLEGAL MANUFACTURE OF FIREARMS, LIGHT WEAPONS OR AMMUNITION.

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6 7 "If homicide or murder is committed with the use of an unlicensed firearm OR LIGHT WEAPON, such use of an unlicensed firearm OR LIGHT WEAPON shall be considered as an aggravating circumstance.

8 "IF ANY OTHER CRIME PUNISHABLE BY THE REVISED 9 PENAL CODE AND OTHER SPECIAL LAWS WAS COMMITTED BY 10 THE PERSON ARRESTED, THE VIOLATION OF THIS ACT SHALL 11 BE CONSIDERED AS A DISTINCT AND SEPARATE OFFENSE: **PROVIDED**, HOWEVER, THAT [I]If the violation of this [Section] 12 ACT is in furtherance of or incident to, or in connection with the 13 crime of rebellion, or insurrection[, sedition], or attempted *coup* 14 15 d'etat, such violation shall be absorbed as an element of the 16 crime of rebellion, or insurrection, sedition, or attempted *coup* 17 d'etat.

"The [same] penalty OF RECLUSION TEMPORAL IN ITS 18 MAXIMUM PERIOD TO RECLUSION PERPETUA shall be imposed 19 20 upon the owner, president, manager, director or other responsible 21 officer of any public or private firm, company, corporation or 22 entity, who shall willfully or knowingly allow any of the firearms 23 OR AMMUNITION owned by such firm, company, corporation or entity to be used by any person or persons found guilty of 24 25 violating the provisions of the preceding paragraphs or willfully 26 or knowingly allow any of them to use unlicensed firearms or 27 firearms without any legal authority to be carried outside of their 28 residence in the course of their employment.

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1	"The penalty of [arresto mayor] PRISION CORRECCIONAL
2	IN ITS MINIMUM PERIOD TO PRISION MAYOR IN ITS MINIMUM
3	PERIOD AND A FINE OF TWENTY THOUSAND PESOS
4	(P20,000.00) shall be imposed upon any person who shall carry
5	any licensed firearm outside his residence without legal authority
6	therefor."
7	SEC. 2. Section 2 of the same Decree on "Presumption of Illegal
8	Manufacture of Firearms or Ammunition" is hereby deleted.
9	SEC. 3. Section 5 of the same Decree, as amended, is hereby further
10	amended to read as follows:
11	"SEC. 5. Tampering of Firearm[']s [Serial Number]. –
12	ANY MODIFICATION MADE ON A FIREARM THAT SHALL ALTER
13	ITS IDENTITY, INFORMATION OR BALLISTIC CHARACTERISTIC
14	SHALL REQUIRE THE ISSUANCE OF A NEW LICENSE.
15	The penalty of [prision correccional] RECLUSION TEMPORAL IN
16	ITS MAXIMUM PERIOD TO RECLUSION PERPETUA shall be
17	imposed upon any person who shall unlawfully tamper[,] WITH,
18	change, deface or erase the serial number, OR MODIFY THE
19	IDENTITY, INFORMATION OR BALLISTIC CHARACTERISTIC of
20	any firearm."
21	SEC. 4. New sections designated as Sections 7, 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 are
22	hereby inserted to read as follows:
23	"SEC. 7. FIREARMS, LIGHT WEAPONS OR AMMUNITION
24	IN 'CUSTODIA LEGIS' DURING THE PENDENCY OF THE CASE,
25	SEIZED FIREARMS, LIGHT WEAPONS, AMMUNITION,
26	MACHINERY, TOOLS OR INSTRUMENTS SHALL NOT BE
27	DISPOSED OF, ALIENATED OR TRANSFERRED BUT SHALL BE IN
28	THE CUSTODY OF THE COURT OR IN 'CUSTODIA LEGIS':

1 **PROVIDED, THAT THE COURT SHALL AUTHORIZE THE PNP TO** 2 HOLD SUCH FIREARMS, LIGHT WEAPONS, MACHINERY, TOOLS 3 **OR INSTRUMENTS FOR SAFEKEEPING DURING THE PENDENCY** OF THE CASE AND TO DELIVER THE SAME TO THE COURT WHEN 4 5 SO ORDERED: PROVIDED, FURTHER, THAT NO BOND SHALL BE ADMITTED FOR THE RELEASE OF THE SAME: PROVIDED, 6 7 FINALLY, THAT ANY VIOLATION HEREOF SHALL BE. 8 PUNISHABLE BY RECLUSION TEMPORAL TO RECLUSION 9 PERPETUA."

10 "SEC. 8. CONFISCATION AND FORFEITURE. - EVERY 11 PENALTY IMPOSED FOR VIOLATION OF THE PROVISIONS OF 12 THIS ACT SHALL CARRY WITH IT THE ACCESSORY PENALTY OF CONFISCATION AND FORFEITURE OF THE FIREARMS, LIGHT 13 14 WEAPONS. AMMUNITION. MACHINERY, TOOLS OR 15 INSTRUMENTS IN FAVOR OF THE GOVERNMENT WHICH SHALL 16 BE DISPOSED OF IN ACCORDANCE WITH LAW."

17 "SEC. 9. LIABILITY FOR PLANTING OF EVIDENCE 18 **CONCERNING FIREARMS. LIGHT WEAPONS AND AMMUNITION. –** 19 THE PENALTY OF RECLUSION TEMPORAL IN ITS MAXIMUM 20 PERIOD SHALL BE IMPOSED UPON ANY PERSON WHO SHALL 21 WILLFULLY, MALICIOUSLY AND SURREPTITIOUSLY INSERT, 22 PLACE, ADD OR ATTACH, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, THROUGH 23 ANY OVERT OR COVERT ACT, ANY FIREARM, LIGHT WEAPON 24 OR AMMUNITION IN THE PERSON, HOUSE, EFFECTS OR IN THE 25 IMMEDIATE VICINITY OF AN INNOCENT INDIVIDUAL FOR THE 26 PURPOSE OF IMPLICATING OR INCRIMINATING HIM/HER OR 27 IMPUTING THE COMMISSION OF ANY VIOLATION OF THE 28 **PROVISIONS OF THIS ACT TO SAID INDIVIDUAL:** *PROVIDED.* 29 THAT IF THE PERSON FOUND GUILTY HEREIN IS A PUBLIC 30 OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE, HE/SHE SHALL SUFFER THE PENALTY 31 **OF RECLUSION PERPETUA."**

1"SEC. 10. ILLEGAL TRANSFER OF FIREARMS. -- IT2SHALL BE UNLAWFUL FOR ANY SELLER TO TRANSFER THE3POSSESSION OF ANY FIREARM OR AMMUNITION OR ANY PART4OF A FIREARM TO A BUYER WHO HAS NOT YET OBTAINED OR5SECURED THE NECESSARY LICENSE OR PERMIT THEREOF.

6 "ANY PERSON WHO SHALL VIOLATE THE PROVISION OF
7 THE PRECEDING PARAGRAPH SHALL BE DISQUALIFIED TO
8 APPLY FOR A LICENSE TO POSSESS OTHER FIREARMS AND ALL
9 HIS EXISTING FIREARMS LICENSES SHALL BE REVOKED.

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 "ANY PUBLIC OFFICER OR PERSONNEL WHO SHALL

 11
 KNOWINGLY REGISTER AN UNLICENSED OR STOLEN FIREARM

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 SHALL SUFFER THE PENALTY OF PRISION CORRECCIONAL IN ITS

 13
 MINIMUM PERIOD TO PRISION MAYOR."

14 "SEC. 11. ISSUANCE. REVOCATION. CANCELLATION AND 15 SUSPENSION OF LICENSES AND PERMITS. - FIREARMS HAVE TO BE REGISTERED WITH THE FIREARMS AND EXPLOSIVES 16 17 **DIVISON OF THE PHILIPPINE NATIONAL POLICE (FED-PNP)** 18 TO BE CONSIDERED LICENSED. THE CHIEF, PNP OR HIS 19 AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE SHALL ISSUE LICENSES AND 20 OTHER PERMITS TO ANY QUALIFIED NATURAL OR JURIDICAL 21 PERSON WHO SHALL ACOUIRE, POSSESS, DEAL IN, SELL OR 22 DISPOSE FIREARMS, PARTS OF FIREARMS, AMMUNITION AND 23 AMMUNITION COMPONENTS. HE MAY ISSUE A PERMIT TO 24 CARRY A FIREARM OUTSIDE OF RESIDENCE TO ANY OUALIFIED 25 PERSON IN MERITORIOUS CASES AS MAY BE DETERMINED BY 26 HIM AND UNDER CONDITIONS HE MAY IMPOSE.

27 "LIKEWISE, ANY PERSON WHO SHALL MANUFACTURE
28 OR REPAIR FIREARMS, LIGHT WEAPONS, PARTS OF FIREARMS,
29 AMMUNITION, AMMUNITION COMPONENTS, INSTRUMENTS
30 USED OR INTENDED TO BE USED IN THE MANUFACTURE OF
31 FIREARMS, LIGHT WEAPONS, PARTS OF FIREARMS,

AMMUNITION AND AMMUNITION COMPONENTS SHALL FIRST SECURE A LICENSE FROM THE CHIEF, PNP.

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3 **"FIREARMS WITH EXPIRED LICENSES WHICH HAVE NOT** 4 BEEN RENEWED FOR A PERIOD OF SIX (6) MONTHS FROM THE 5 DATE OF EXPIRATION THEREOF SHALL BE SURRENDERED. 6 CONFISCATED OR FORFEITED IN FAVOR OF THE GOVERNMENT 7 AFTER DUE PROCESS. ALL OTHER EXISTING FIREARMS LICENSES OF SUCH HOLDER OF AN UNRENEWED LICENSE 8 9 SHALL BE SUBSEQUENTLY REVOKED AND SUBJECT FIREARMS 10 SHALL LIKEWISE BE SURRENDERED, CONFISCATED OR FORFEITED IN FAVOR OF THE GOVERNMENT. SAID HOLDER OF 11 12 THE FIREARM/S SHALL BE PERPETUALLY DISOUALIFIED FROM 13 **APPLYING FOR ANY FIREARM LICENSE."**

14"SEC. 12. GROUNDS FOR REVOCATION, CANCELLATION15OR SUSPENSION OF LICENSE OR PERMIT. - THE CHIEF, PNP16OR HIS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE MAY REVOKE, CANCEL17OR SUSPEND A LICENSE OR PERMIT ON THE FOLLOWING18GROUNDS:

19 "(A) COMMISSION OF A CRIME INVOLVING A FIREARM
20 WHICH IS PUNISHABLE BY THE REVISED PENAL CODE AND
21 SPECIAL LAWS;

(B) CONVICTION BY A COMPETENT COURT OF A
CRIME INVOLVING MORAL TURPITUDE OR ANY OFFENSE
WHERE THE PENALTY CARRIES AN IMPRISONMENT OF MORE
THAN SIX (6) MONTHS OR A FINE OF AT LEAST ONE THOUSAND
PESOS (P1,000.00);

27 "(C) LOSS OF FIREARM THROUGH NEGLIGENCE;
28 "(D) CARRYING OF FIREARM IN PROHIBITED PLACES;
29 "(E) CARRYING OF FIREARM OUTSIDE RESIDENCE OR
30 WORKPLACE WITHOUT A PERMIT TO CARRY A FIREARM;

1 "(F) UNAUTHORIZED LOAN OF FIREARM TO ANOTHER 2 PERSON;

3 "(G) DISMISSAL FOR CAUSE FROM THE SERVICE, IN
4 CASE OF GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS/EMPLOYEES;

5 "(H) COMMISSION OF ANY OF THE ACTS PENALIZED
6 UNDER REPUBLIC ACT NO. 9165 OR THE 'COMPREHENSIVE
7 DANGEROUS DRUGS ACT OF 2002'; AND

8 "(1) SUBMISSION OF FALSIFIED DOCUMENTS OR 9 MISREPRESENTATION IN THE APPLICATION TO OBTAIN A 10 LICENSE OR PERMIT."

SEC. 5. The PNP shall issue within ninety (90) days after the approval
of this Act, the necessary rules and regulations relating to the administrative
aspect of the provisions of this Act.

14 SEC. 6. If, for any reason, any section or provision of this Act is 15 declared to be unconstitutional or invalid, the other sections or provisions 16 hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and 17 effect.

18 SEC. 7. All laws, decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations and
19 other issuances or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Act are hereby
20 repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

SEC. 8. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
