







AN ACT RENAMING THE BACACA ROAD WHICH CONNECTS
J.P. LAUREL STREET AND CARLOS P. GARCIA HIGHWAY
THAT LEADS TO DAVAO CITY INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AS
FRANCISCO S. DIZON ROAD

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. The Bacaca Road which connects J.P. Laurel Street and
2 Carlos P. Garcia Highway that leads to Davao City International Airport shall
3 hereinafter be known as Francisco S. Dizon Road.

4 SEC. 2. The Department of Public Works and Highways shall issue the
5 necessary rules, orders and circulars to implement the provision of this Act.

6 SEC. 3. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication
7 in a newspaper of general circulation.
