RESOLUTION

CONGRATULATING AND COMMENDING THE MEMBERS OF TEAM PHILIPPINES FOR WINNING 23 MEDALS, INCLUDING ONE GOLD, TWELVE SILVER AND TEN BRONZE MEDALS, IN THE 9TH INTERNATIONAL SCIENCE OLYMPIAD (IMSO) FOR PRIMARY MATHEMATICS AND STUDENTS HELD IN LUCKNOW, INDIA FROM OCTOBER 29 NOVEMBER 2, 2012.
