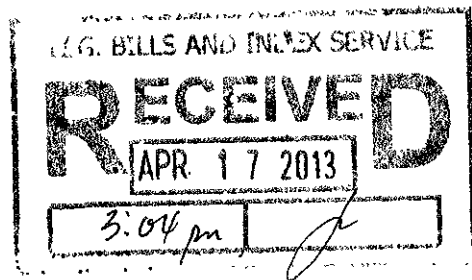

RESOLUTION

COMMENDING THE MINORITY LEADER, HONORABLE ALAN PETER COMPANERO S. CAYETANO, FOR HIS EXEMPLARY DEDICATION TO DUTY DURING THE THIRD REGULAR SESSION OF THE FIFTEENTH CONGRESS

WHEREAS, Honorable Alan Peter Companero S. Cayetano, a fearless critic of corruption, and an articulate interpellator during plenary debates of the Senate, has effectively performed his duty as Minority Leader with utmost candor and dedication;

WHEREAS, as Minority Leader, he strongly expressed his advocacy towards transparency, accountability and good governance in all branches of government;

WHEREAS, his brilliant, astute and incisive legal views as Senator-Judge in the Corona Trial enriched the deliberations in the Senate sitting as an Impeachment Court;

WHEREAS, his concern to make education more responsive and accessible to deserving students found a voice in his bill mandating all state college and universities to confer automatic admission and scholarship grants annually to the top ten graduating public high school students and his bill providing support mechanism for programs of the Department of Education that are geared to advance the interest of children with special needs;

WHEREAS, he likewise proposed key amendments to the Enhanced Basic Education (K-12) Law providing for a mandatory midterm review of the program, the creation of a Joint Congressional Oversight Committee, and a commitment for the Department of Education to increase per capita spending on education towards the attainment of international benchmarks;

WHEREAS, he is a human rights advocate, and an ardent protector of the rights of the minority in the chamber: *Now therefore, be it*
