EXPLANATORY NOTE

The current quarters allowance of the officers and enlisted personnel of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) is as follows:

It is evident that the present rate is not enough to support decent quarters in view of the current rate of house rental that overwhelms the living conditions of military personnel and their families. Thus, it is necessary to seek for an increase in the quarters allowance of officers and enlisted personnel of the AFP.

Adequate support and incentives to the military personnel is one way of motivating them, considering the serious and demanding nature of their profession.

AN ACT

INCREASING THE QUARTERS ALLOWANCE OF OFFICERS AND ENLISTED PERSONNEL OF THE ARMED FORCES OF THE PHILIPPINES AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Be in enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

- SECTION 1. It is hereby declared the policy of the State to promote professionalism in
- 2 the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) and to provide adequate remuneration and benefits to
- 3 its members. Pursuant thereto, the government shall provide adequate support and incentives to
- 4 the members of the Armed Forces.

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- SEC. 2. The officers and enlisted personnel of the AFP shall be provided with housing
- 7 facilities consistent with the requirements of the service. Allowances per capita shall be provided
 - for all officers and enlisted personnel to attain this objective. Such allowances may be commuted
- 9 if no housing facilities can be made available.

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SEC. 3. In order to upgrade the morale of the AFP, the quarters allowance for married officers and enlisted personnel shall be adjusted in accordance with the following rate:

- SEC. 6. All laws, decrees, executive orders, rules and regulations inconsistent with this

 Act, are hereby repealed, amended or modifies accordingly.
- SEC. 7. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its complete publication in the Official Gazette or in two (2) national newspapers of general circulation.
