EXPLANATORY NOTE

This bill seeks to convert the Osmeña National High School in Osmeña, Marabut, Samar into an agro-industrial high school to be renamed the Osmeña Agro-Industrial High School. The said school will offer agriculture and industrial arts subjects in addition to the basic curriculum presently being offered.

The local economy of Samar is predominantly agricultural, as is the rest of the country. Training in modern methods of agriculture would give the local students skills that would be immediately useful in their families' farms and the industrial enterprises in the surrounding area, and support the national goals of agricultural modernization and food security.

This bill is a response to the request of local government officials who have identified this measure as one of their priorities.

In view of the foregoing, early passage of this bill is earnestly requested.

AN ACT
CONVERTING THE PRESENT OSMEÑA NATIONAL HIGH SCHOOL IN
BARANGAY OSMEÑA, MUNICIPALITY OF MARABUT, PROVINCE OF SAMAR
INTO AN AGRO-INDUSTRIAL SCHOOL TO BE KNOWN AS THE OSMEÑA AGRO-
INDUSTRIAL HIGH SCHOOL

*Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Republic of the
Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. The present Osmeña National High School in Barangay
2 Osmeña, Municipality of Marabut, Province of Samar is hereby converted into
3 an agro-industrial high school to be known as the Osmeña Agro-Industrial High
4 School

5 SEC. 2. The Secretary of Education Culture and Sports shall issue such
6 rules and regulations as may be necessary to carry out the purpose of this Act.

7 SEC. 3. The amount necessary to carry out the provisions of this Act
8 shall be included in the General Appropriations Act of the year following its
9 enactment into law and every year thereafter.

10 SEC. 4. This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its publication in
11 two (2) national newspapers of general circulation
