EXPLANATORY NOTE

The Constitution, Article 11, Section 15 provides that "The State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instil health consciousness among them."

Milk consumers are poorly informed about the contents of the milk they acquire from the market. There is currently no uniform standard as to the contents of the skim milk, low fat milk, and milk as beverage in final package.

In accordance with this constitutional mandate, this bill provides for the proper labelling of milk products indicating distinctly in its package the non-fat and protein content of the milk and sets standards on the contents of milk solids that are fat in the classification of skim milk, low fat milk and milk as beverage. With this innovation it is expected that the consuming public will be informed about the nutritional contents and value of the milk they consume. The quality of milk will likewise be upgraded in order to conform to proper nutritional standards.^{*}

1 2 3	AN ACT ESTABLISHING STANDARDS FOR THE IDENTITY OF MILK AND REQUIRING THE LABELING THEREOF
	Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:
4	SECTION 1, Short Title This Act may be cited as the "Milk Nutrition and Labelling
5	Act."
6	SECTION 2. Milk Labelling The following shall apply in establishing standards of
7	identity for milk:
8	(A) Fluid milk shall indicate on its label such portion of milk which is non-fat;
9	(B) Skim milk that is final package form for beverage use shall contain not less than nine
10	percent (9%) of milk solids that are non-fat;
11	(C) Low fat milk that is in final package form for beverage use shall contain not less than
12	ten (10%) of milk solids that are non-fat;
13	(D) Milk that is in final package form for beverage use shall contain not less than eight
14	percent (8%) of milk solids that are non-fat;
15	(E) That label on any milk product shall prominently display the nutritional contents and
16	value of the milk.

17	SECTION 3. Penalties The Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) shall promulgate
18	rules on recall of products which fail to comply with the requirements under this Act. The
19	manufacturer of the products so recalled shall also pay a fine as determined by DTI based on the

extent of the distribution of such product but shall not be more than TEN MILLION PESOS
(P10,000,000.00)

3 SECTION 4. *Separability Clause.* - If any provision or part hereof is held invalid or 4 unconstitutional, the remainder of the law of the provision not otherwise affected shall remain 5 valid and subsisting.

6 SECTION 5. *Repealing Clause.* - Any law, presidential decree or issuance, executive 7 order, letter of instruction, administrative order, rule, or regulation contrary to or inconsistent 8 with the provisions of this Act is hereby repealed, modified, or amended accordingly.

9 SECTION 6. *Effectivity Clause*. - This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after its
10 publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
