EXPLANATORY NOTE

The bill seeks the following amendment to the Administrative Code:

"SEC. 26. Automatic Appropriations. - All expenditures for Personnel Retirement Premiums, Government Service Insurance, and other similar Fixed Expenditures are automatically appropriated: *Provided*, That no obligations shall be incurred or interests made from funds thus automatically appropriated except as issued in form of Regular Budgetary Allotments."

The purpose is not to leave hanging critical lifeline support such as personal retirement premiums and the like.

AN ACT AMENDING SECTION 26, CHAPTER 4, BOOK VI OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE CODE OF 1987

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Section 26, Chapter 4 of the Administrative Code is hereby amended to read:

- "SEC. 26. Automatic Appropriations. All expenditures for Personnel Retirement Premiums, Government Service Insurance, and other similar Fixed Expenditures are automatically appropriated: *Provided*, That no obligations shall be incurred or interests made from funds thus automatically appropriated except as issued in form of Regular Budgetary Allotments."
- SEC. 2 All laws, orders, decrees, proclamations, rules and regulations or parts hereof which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed or modified accordingly.
- SEC. 3 This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days following its publication in at least two (2) newspapers of general circulation.
