

RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE SOLDIERS OF THE 14TH INFANTRY BATTALION DEPLOYED TO GUIUAN, EASTERN SAMAR IN RECOGNITION OF THEIR INCREDIBLE ACTS OF BRAVERY IN THE WAKE OF TYPHOON YOLANDA
