RESOLUTION

URGING THE PROPER SENATE COMMITTEES TO EVALUATE THE CURRENT NBI CLEARANCE APPLICATION PROCESS WITH THE INTENTION OF RECOMMENDING MEASURES FOR A FASTER AND ACCESSIBLE NBI CLEARANCE APPLICATION SYSTEM NATIONWIDE

WHEREAS, reports surfaced that the new National Bureau of Investigation (NBI) Clearance application process has been creating delays, backlogs and long lines;

WHEREAS, NBI officer-in-charge Medardo de Lemos explained that they are currently having a hard time processing clearance applications as they have implemented a new system after their contract with their service provider expired last December 31, 2013¹;

WHEREAS, at present, the new system is solely implemented in NBI's office in Manila and will be implemented in other offices nationwide as soon as they have purchased the necessary hardware²;

WHEREAS, a daily average of more than twenty-one thousand (21,000) people were issued clearances by the NBI over the past two-and-a-half years³;

WHEREAS, from January to November 2013, a total of 5,633,845 clearances or a daily average of around 16,000 clearances was issued⁴;

WHEREAS, NBI Clearance is a requirement in job applications and in applications for registration, permits or licenses from government agencies;

WHEREAS, there is a need to create a faster and accessible NBI clearance application system nationwide to address the increasing demand of Filipinos for expeditious delivery of government service;
