#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

The alarming rise in the country's crime rate today makes it compelling for agencies and personnel involved in the criminal justice system to have the scientific and medical capability to evaluate and analyze physical evidence. Though efforts of prosecution lawyers and law enforcers are directed towards the solution of crimes, it has become imperative to develop a corps of professionals expert in forensic investigations.

The proposed bill seeks to establish a Forensic Science Institute in the University of the Philippines system for the purpose of providing competent, scientific and modern technical services and advanced medical facilities for the detection and investigation of crimes. It also aims to improve existing forensic laboratories and upgrade the skills of those already involved in forensic science.

Furthermore, the establishment of a Forensic Institute in the UP System will address concerns on the objectivity of cases solved by the Philippine National Police and the National Bureau of Investigation. Though the integrity of both PNP and NBI is not in question, we know that these institutions operate crime laboratories that perform physical evidence analyses and examination. Both however, are also involved in the prosecution of crimes that, expectedly, results in findings which tend to corroborate their theory of cases under investigation.

The University of the Philippines will be in unchallenged position of conducting professional work though modern scientific methods and instrumentation of forensic investigation.

Establishing a Forensic Science Institute in the state-run university, known for its commitment in upholding academic truth and excellence will help immensely in crime solution.

In view of the foregoing, the passage of this bill is earnestly sought.

#### AN ACT

# ESTABLISHING THE FORENSIC SCIENCE INSTITUTE IN THE UNIVERSITY OF THE PHILIPPINES SYSTEM, DEFINING ITS FUNCTIONS AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SECTION 1. Title. - This Act shall be known as the "Forensic Science Institute Act of 2004."

**SECTION 2.** Creation and Objective of the Institute. – There is hereby created a Forensic Science Institute in the University of the Philippines System with the following objectives:

(a) To promote research and development in the various fields of forensic science and advance the search for truth;

(b) To enhance the competence and capabilities of existing laboratories in the country and prepare them for accreditation;

(c) To develop a corps of professionals and prepare them for a career in forensic science; and

(d) To train and upgrade the technical, scientific and management skills of personnel presently involved in forensic science so as to improve the administration of justice.

SECTION 3. Delegation of Authority to the Board of Regents. — The Board of Regents of the University of the Philippines System is hereby authorized to establish the Forensic Science Institute under the direct supervision of the Office of the President of the University, which shall have a faculty and staff with expertise in the disciplines of biology, chemistry, law, medicine, molecular biology, social sciences, statistics and other pertinent disciplines, who may be drawn within the System or outside.

1	SECTION 4. Functions of the Institute The Forensic Science Institute will have
2	the following functions:

4	(a) To provide competent scientific and advance medical and technical services for
5	the detection and investigation of crimes.
6	
7	(b) To maintain a network of modern laboratories for the development and adoption
8	of analytical methods and procedures related to forensic evidence;
9	
10	(c) To offer degree and non-degree programs to students inclined towards the various
11	areas of forensic science;
12	
13	(d) To undertake research in all fields of forensic science; and
14	
15	(e) To provide continuing education on modern scientific methods and
16	instrumentation and on validation of forensic evidence to technicians and
17 18	personnel of existing laboratories, medical centers, and educational institutions.
19	SECTION 5. Implementing Authority The Board of Regents of the University of
20	the Philippines System is hereby mandated to formulate implementing guidelines to carry out
21	the provisions of this Act and to take appropriate steps to ensure that the establishment of the
22	Forensic Science institute shall aim at the speedy realization of the objectives and at the
23	execution of the powers and functions stated above. Towards this end, the Board shall
24	determine the structure, composition, and size of the Institute's faculty and staff.

26	SECTION 6. Appropriations The amount of Three Hundred Million Pesos
27	(P300,000,000) is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the National Treasury not
28	otherwise appropriated to carry out the objectives and provisions of this Act from its
29	effectivity until the next fiscal year 2002-2003. Thereafter, such sums as may be necessary to
30	carry out the provisions of the Act shall be included in the subsequent annual General
31	Appropriations Act under the University of the Philippines System.

33	<b>SECTION 7.</b> Repealing Clause. – All laws, rules and regulations, or part thereof,
34	inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, amend or modified
35	accordingly.
