## RESOLUTION

COMMENDING FOUR (4) FEMALE ROOKIE MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION POLICE OFFICE - REGIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY BATALLION OF THE PHILIPINE NATIONAL POLICE AND RECOGNIZING THEIR ACTS OF BRAVERY IN THE MIDST OF THE ROBBERY AND SHOOTOUT ON 30 MARCH 2014 AT THE MALL OF ASIA, PASAY CITY

WHEREAS, on Sunday, 30 March 2014, a band of robbers engaged in a shootout members of the Philippine National Police (PNP) inside the Mall of Asia, one of the world's largest shopping malls, thereby sending shoppers scrambling for safety<sup>1</sup>;

WHEREAS, said band of robbers, armed with guns and pipe wrenches, smashed the display cases of two jewelry stalls inside the mall and were able to steal the contents;

WHEREAS, amidst the commotion, four (4) female rookie members of the PNP's National Capital Region Police Office - Regional Public Safety Battalion (NCRPO-RPSB) assigned to man the Police Assistance Desk at the mall, were among the first responders, as they pursued and exchanged fire with the suspects;

WHEREAS, in fact, one of the female cops shot and wounded one of the robbers who was carrying a caliber .45 handgun and who was firing the same to scare shoppers<sup>2</sup>; hence, the female cops were able to arrest him;

WHEREAS, the speedy and determined response of the four (4) female rookie cops, identified later as Police Officers 1 Juliet Macabadbad, Delia Langpawen, Marcelina Bantiag, and Maricel Rueco<sup>3</sup>, prevented the robbers from further stealing more pieces of jewelry from said shops, and further posing grave danger to the shoppers;

WHEREAS, the courage and quick thinking of these four (4) female rookie cops and other police officers in carrying out their duty to protect the people and in preserving peace and order, merit the commendation and recognition of the Filipino people;
