**AN ACT RENAMING THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AS THE
DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES**

Be it enacted by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:

SEC. 1. The Department of Agriculture is hereby renamed as the Department of Agriculture and Fisheries.

SEC. 2. *Repealing Clause.* – All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations, and other issuances which are inconsistent with this Act are hereby repealed or amended accordingly.

SEC. 3. *Effectivity.* This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication in any newspaper of general circulation.
