AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY
VICTORIA REYES IN THE CITY OF DASMARIÑAS, PROVINCE
OF CAVITE

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay Victoria Reyes.* – There is hereby
2 created a barangay to be known as Barangay Victoria Reyes in the City of
3 Dasmariñas, Province of Cavite.

4 SEC. 2. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.* – The plebiscite
5 conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC)
6 pursuant to Provincial Ordinance No. 2000-004 of the Sangguniang
7 Panlalawigan of the Province of Cavite, which ratified the creation of
8 Barangay Victoria Reyes as proclaimed by the Plebiscite Board of Canvassers
9 on October 19, 2003, shall serve as substantial compliance with the plebiscite
10 requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended,
11 otherwise known as the “Local Government Code of 1991”.

12 SEC. 3. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.* – The incumbent barangay
13 officials of Barangay Victoria Reyes, City of Dasmariñas, Province of Cavite

1 shall continue to hold office until such time that their successors have been
2 duly elected and qualified.

3 SEC. 4. *Public Infrastructures and Facilities.* – All existing public
4 infrastructures and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
5 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to and
6 shall be administered by the new barangay.

7 SEC. 5. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.* – Barangay Victoria
8 Reyes shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant to
9 Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the
10 “Local Government Code of 1991”.

11 SEC. 6. *Separability Clause.* – If, for any reason, any part or provision
12 of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, other parts or provisions
13 which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

14 SEC. 7. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
15 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in a newspaper of general circulation.
