



*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in Congress assembled:*

1 AN ACT  
2 PROHIBITING CARD ISSUERS FROM ACCEPTING THIRD-PARTY SOURCED  
3 PERSONAL INFORMATION

4 SECTION 1. *Prohibited User Information Requests.* – Issuers of Credit/Debit  
5 Cards are prohibited from knowingly accepting or soliciting the personal information of a  
6 card holder from a third-party.

7 SECTION 2. *Penalty.* – Upon conviction of a violation of this Act, a fine of One  
8 Hundred Thousand Pesos (₱100,000.00) per occurrence shall be imposed.

9 SECTION 3. *Repealing Clause.* – All laws, decrees, orders, rules and regulations  
10 or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, amended  
11 or modified accordingly.

12 SECTION 4. *Effectivity Clause.* – This Act shall take effect after fifteen (15) days  
13 following its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in two (2) newspapers of general  
14 circulation.
