RESOLUTION

REMINDING THE ENTIRE NATION OF THE SACRIFICES AND HEROIC DEEDS OF FORMER PRESIDENT MANUEL L. QUEZON AND FORMER SENATOR BENIGNO "NINOY" AQUINO, JR.

WHEREAS, on August 19, 2004, the country celebrated the birth anniversary of a great Filipino, former President Manuel L. Quezon, the first President of the Philippine Commonwealth and former Senate President, while on August 21 of this same year, we commemorate the death anniversary of Benigno "Ninoy" Aquino, Jr., a former Senator and strong proponent of freedom and democracy.

WHEREAS, we remember President Quezon as a statesman who chartered the country's destiny and sacrificed his life at the time when the world was rocked by disorder; a man who may be credited for ameliorating the plight of the poor and for his advocacy of social justice;
