1 2 3 4	RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE PROPER SENATE COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE REPORTED PRACTICE OF 'HULIDAP' OR EXTORTION BY POLICE OFFICERS DURING ARREST
5	WHEREAS, the Constitution, Article 2, Section 5, provides: "The maintenance of peace
6	and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property, and promotion of the general welfare are
7	essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy";
8 9 10	WHEREAS, the Constitution further provides, in Article 2, Section 27: "The State shall maintain honesty and integrity in the public service and take positive and effective measures against graft and corruption";
11 12	WHEREAS, the <i>Philippine Star</i> on 7 May 2015 reported that five operatives of the Quezon City Police District (QCPD) are facing dismissal from the service for allegedly
13	attempting to extort ₽30,000 from a 37-year-old vendor they arrested;
14	WHEREAS, the police officers allegedly barged into the San Juan home of Rey
15 16	Manlapaz without any warrant, and arrested the latter for supposed possession of illegal drugs and firearms;
17 18	WHEREAS, Manlapaz claimed that the charges were false, and accused his arrestors of unlawfully demanding P30,000 in exchange for his release;
19	WHEREAS, Manlapaz was released after his brother sought police help;
20	WHEREAS, the Star said QCPD director Chief Superintendent Joel Pagdilao has vowed
21	to charge the police officers involved with robbery, extortion, unlawful arrest, arbitrary
22	detention, and physical injury;
23	WHEREAS, social media is rife with complaints about the same modus operandi, which
24	has been tagged as "hulidap";
25	WHEREAS, the practice of "hulidap" must be eliminated to restore the integrity of the
26	police force, which has the prime duty of protecting citizens;

SENATE P. S. R. No. **1346**  WHEREAS, Congress must intensify existing legislation to penalize erring members of
 the national civilian law enforcement agency;

WHEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE PHILIPPINE SENATE to direct
the proper Senate committee to conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, on the reported practice
of 'hulidap' or extortion by police officers during arrest.
