RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE PROPER SENATE COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE COMMISSION ON AUDIT REPORT QUESTIONING DAVAO CITY'S 11,246 CONTRACTUAL WORKERS IN 2014

WH	EREAS, the Consti	tution, Article	2, Section 27	provides: '	"The State	shall mai	ntain
honesty and	l integrity in the pul	olic service and	d take positive	and effecti	ve measure	s against	graft
and corrupt	ion";						

WHEREAS, the Constitution also provides in Article 2, Section 28: "Subject to reasonable conditions prescribed by law, the State adopts and implements a policy of full public disclosure of all its transactions involving public interest";

WHEREAS, news website *Rappler* on 16 June 2015 reported that state auditors are questioning the Davao City government for 11,246 contractual workers in 2014, which cost the city government \$\mathbb{P}708\$ million;

WHEREAS, the Commission on Audit (COA) reportedly doubted the necessity and regularity of 4,754 job orders that are all for the city mayor's office;

WHEREAS, lack of clear hiring policies in Davao City allegedly fosters political patronage by leaving the identification of persons to be hired, especially for contractual and job order vacancies, to the discretion of city officials;

WHEREAS, the COA claimed that of the 14,499 persons on the city government's payroll, only 3,253 hold regular positions and receive their salaries from the city's personal services budget, while the 6,081 contractual employees and 5,165 job orders were paid from budget for maintenance and other operating expenses;

WHEREAS, state auditors reportedly expressed concern over the absence of daily time records or attendance logs, and the failure to specify the functions and duties of workers in contracts;

WHEREAS, the COA further questioned why some employees remain in contractual capacity despite having worked in the Davao for more than a decade;

WHEREAS, the government must uphold the principle of meritocracy in the civil service in a bid to improve the delivery of public services and to curb the practice of peddling positions in the bureaucracy for political patronage; WHEREAS, Congress, alongside its exercise of the power of the purse, must ensure that local governments are using public funds judiciously;

WHEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE PHILIPPINE SENATE to direct the proper Senate committee to conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, on the Commission on Audit report questioning Davao City's 11,246 contractual workers in 2014.
