RESOLUTION

DIRECTING THE PROPER SENATE COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON REPORTED BUDGET CUTS AND PRIVATIZATION SCHEMES UNDER THE UNIVERSAL HEALTH PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Constitution, Article 2, Section 15 provides: "The State shall protect and promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them";

WHEREAS, the *Manila Bulletin* on 19 June 2015 reported that a health advocacy group is protesting the administration's Universal Health Care program which has reportedly made health services inaccessible to people;

WHEEAS, the news quoted the Alliance of Health Workers (AHW), which said that budget cuts and privatization schemes under the Kalusugang Pangkalahatan (Universal Health Care) program has reduced the Department of Health into a regulatory and monitoring body instead of a social service provider;

WHEREAS, reduced budget for medicine, supplies, and operating expenses in public hospitals have allegedly led to increase in payments even among indigent patients;

WHEREAS, more and more public hospitals, including the Jose Reyes Memorial Medical Center, San Lazaro Hospital, and Dr. Jose Fabella Memorial Hospital, are also purportedly being privatized;

WHEREAS, Congress, in consultation with the Department of Health, the Department of Social Welfare and Development, and other concerned agencies, must strengthen existing laws to ensure that universal public access to health services remains a top government priority;

WHEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE PHILIPPINE SENATE to direct the proper Senate committee to conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, on the reported budget cuts and privatization schemes under the Universal Health Program.
