	Introduced by Senator Miriam Defensor Santiago
	RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE PROPER SENATE COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE NEED TO STRENGTHEN LAWS AGAINST THE ILLEGAL PRACTICE OF MEDICINE
1	WHEREAS, the Constitution, Article 2, Section 15 provides: "The State shall protect and
2	promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them";
3	WHEREAS, a petition launched in June through online platform Change.org is calling on
4	law enforcement agencies to stop a businesswoman who purports to be a licensed physician from
5	practicing medicine;
6	WHEREAS, in an open letter, Bernard Tan urged Justice Secretary Leila De Lima,
7	National Bureau of Investigation Chief Virgilio Mendez, and Professional Regulation
8	Commission Chair Teresita Manzala to act on cases he has filed against businesswoman Antonia
9	Carandang-Park;
10	WHEREAS, Tan reportedly sought murder and estafa charges against Park in 2013,
11	months after his daughter, Kate, died following a stem cell treatment and a juice diet Park
12	prescribed for Hodgkin's lymphoma;
13	WHEREAS, public prosecutors in April 2015 purportedly filed only illegal practice of
14	medicine and estafa against Park;
15	WHEREAS, Tan in his online signature campaign claimed that Park continues to practice
16	medicine despite the charges filed against her;
17	WHEREAS, the <i>Philippine Daily Inquirer</i> also reported in 2014 that a licensed physician
18 19	previously associated with Park's clinic in Tagaytay has testified that Park misrepresented herself as a medical doctor;
20 21	WHEREAS, some 7,000 Filipinos have so far signed the online petition for immediate
21	action against Park;
22	WHEREAS, the government is duty-bound to protect its citizens from unscrupulous
23 24	individuals who claim to be practitioners of medicine and other professions without legitima education, training, and experience;

- WHEREAS, there must be a mechanism to preventively suspend the practice of medical
 doctors and other professionals pending questions of legality;
- WHEREAS, Congress must strengthen existing legislation with the aim of curbing the
 illegal practice of medicine and other professions;
- 5 WHEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE PHILIPPINE SENATE to direct
- 6 the proper Senate committee to conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, on the need to7 strengthen laws against the illegal practice of medicine.
