## RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE PROPER SENATE COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON RECENT LUZON FLOODS

WHEREAS, the Constitution provides, in Article 2, Section 5: "The maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property, and promotion of the general

3 welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy";

WHEREAS, the *Philippine Daily Inquirer* on 20 July 2015 reported that heavy rain

dumped by the southwest monsoon from 14 July to 19 July flooded at least 190 villages in

Luzon, including 100 in Pangasinan;

WHEREAS, civil defense officials claimed that at least four people were reported to have

died as a result of the rains, while about 3,000 were forced to flee to evacuation centers;

9 WHEREAS, the local government must develop mechanisms that will allow authorities

to anticipate the detrimental effects of natural phenomena and to order preemptive evacuation in

the hope of avoiding casualties;

WHEREAS, Congress, through relevant legislation, must empower local governments up

13 to the barangay level to implement disaster risk reduction and management programs;

WHEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE PHILIPPINE SENATE to direct

the proper Senate committee to conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, on recent Luzon floods.
