RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE PROPER SENATE COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE REPORT THAT DOUBLE MALNUTRITION IN THE PHILIPPINES HAS INCREASED

1 WHEREAS, the Constitution, Article 2, Section 15 provides: "The State shall protect and 2 promote the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them"; 3 WHEREAS, the Philippine Star on 6 July 2015 reported that the county is facing a 4 double malnutrition crisis as the number of underweight and overweight adults significantly 5 increased over the past 10 years; 6 WHEREAS, data from the Food and Nutrition Research Institute (FNRI) survey on 7 malnutrition among Filipino adults purportedly showed that from 1993 to 2003, 12.3 percent of 8 adults are undernourished while 24 percent are overweight and obese; 9 WHEREAS, National Nutrition Council (NNC) executive director Maria Bernardita 10 Flores claimed that to address the issue, the NNC would strengthen its Pinggang Pinoy program, 11 which aims to properly explain the food pyramid; 12 WHEREAS, the program reportedly includes the production and dissemination of a new 13 and easy-to-understand food guide that uses familiar food plate models so that the public will 14 know the right food group proportions that will meet their energy and nutrient needs; 15

WHEREAS, Congress, in consultation with relevant agencies, must determine policy support needed to implement the *Pinggang Pinoy* program, especially in remote areas;

WHEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE PHILIPPINE SENATE to direct the proper Senate committee to conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, on the report that double malnutrition in the Philippines has increased.
