

RESOLUTION

HONORING AND COMMENDING THE OUTSTANDING PHILIPPINE SOLDIERS (TOPS) OF 2015 AWARDED BY THE METROBANK FOUNDATION, INC., AND THE ROTARY CLUB OF MAKATI METRO

WHEREAS, the search for the Outstanding Philippine Soldiers T.O.P.S. is an annual search jointly undertaken by the Metrobank Foundation, Inc. (MBFI) and the Rotary Club of Makati (RCMM) in consonance with the conviction of both organizations to honor excellence in the pursuit of a vocation. The partnership of MBFI and RCMM started in 1999;
