RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE PROPER SENATE COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE REPORT THAT CAGAYAN PROVINCE HAS BEEN PLACED UNDER A STATE OF CALAMITY DUE TO THE MASSIVE IMPACT OF A DRY SPELL ON THE CORN INDUSTRY IN THE AREA

WHEREAS, the Constitution, Article 2, Section 5 provides: "The maintenance of peace and order, the protection of life, liberty, and property, and promotion of the general welfare are essential for the enjoyment by all the people of the blessings of democracy";

WHEREAS, the *Manila Bulletin* on 15 April 2015 reported that Cagayan Valley is under a state of calamity due to the dry spell that resulted in some \$\mathbb{P}712\$ million in damage corn crops in 25 municipalities and two cities;

WHEREAS, some 37,000 farmers were allegedly devastated due to the drought which damaged 55,000 metric tons of yellow corn in recent months;

WHEREAS, losses in corn crops are reportedly projected to reach ₱1 billion;

WHEREAS, the declaration of a province-wide state of calamity purportedly released some P123 million in calamity funds as support to the affected farmers;

WHEREAS, Congress, through relevant legislation, must put in place support mechanisms for local government units affected by dry spells;

WHEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE PHILIPPINE SENATE to direct the proper Senate committee to conduct an inquiry, on the report that Cagayan province has been placed under a state of calamity due to the massive impact of a dry spell on the corn industry in the area.
