	RESOLUTION	
	DIRECTING THE PROPER SENATE COMMITTEE TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY. IN AID OF LEGISLATION,	
	ON THE REPORT THAT THE GOVERNMENT OWES VETERANS AND PENSIONERS #17 BILLION IN BENEFITS	
1	WHEREAS, the Constitution provides, in Article 16, Section 7:	
2	The State shall provide immediate and adequate care, benefits, and other	
3	forms of assistance to war veterans and veterans of military campaigns, their	
4	surviving spouses and orphans. Funds shall be provided therefor and due	
5 6	consideration shall be given them in the disposition of agricultural lands of the public domain and, in appropriate cases, in the utilization of natural resources.	
7	WHEREAS, the Philippine Duily Inquirer on 16 September 2015 reported that the	
8	government owes more than 80,000 pensioners, including war veterans and surviving veteran	
9	spouses $P17$ billion in administrative disability benefits;	
10	WHEREAS, the Philippine Veterans Affairs Office (PVAO) allegedly lamented that the	
11	welfare and well-being of the veterans were not being prioritized and that the Congress has failed	
12	to enact laws to upgrade the benefits of pensioners;	
13	. WHEREAS, under the present law, a veteran who reaches 70 years old is deemed totally	
14	disabled and is entitled to a $\ge1,700$ monthly pension;	
15	WHEREAS, as of August 2015, the government's obligation in administrative disability	
16	reportedly totalled #17.53 billion, referring to claims of some 83,346 beneficiaries, including	
17	living veterans, the surviving spouses of deceased veterans, and other pensioners;	
18	WHEREAS, the government must perform its constitutional duty of caring for war	
19	veterans and veterans of military campaigns;	
20	WHEREAS, the Congress, in reviewing the proposed budget for 2016, must ensure that	
21	funds will be appropriated for the state obligations to pensioners;	
22	WHEREAS, the Congress must also strengthen existing laws in order to facilitate the	
23	payment of veterans' benefits;	

- 1 WHEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE PHILIPPINE SENATE to direct
- 2 the proper Senate committee to conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, on the report that the
- 3 government owes veterans and pensioners 17 billion pesos in benefits.
