### RESOLUTION

## DIRECTING THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON HEALTH AND DEMOGRAPHY AND OTHER APPROPRIATE SENATE COMMITTEES TO CONDUCT AN INQUIRY, IN AID OF LEGISLATION, ON THE REPORTED CASES OF JAPANESE ENCEPHALITIS IN THE CORDILLERA REGION

WHEREAS, Section 15 of Article II of the Constitution states: The State shall protect the right to health of the people and instill health consciousness among them;

WHEREAS, news reports indicate that the Department of Health recorded seven (7) cases of Japanese encephalitis in the Cordillera region;

WHEREAS, Japanese encephalitis is a type of viral brain infection that is spread through mosquito bites and is endemic in most of Asia;

WHEREAS, researchers from the University of the Philippines Manila – National Institutes of Health, Institute of Child Health and Human Development, Manila, Philippines, the Philippines Department of Health and Research Institute for Tropical Medicine (RITM) and the World Health Organization Regional Office of the Western Pacific confirmed that Japanese encephalitis has an extensive geographic distribution in all three major island groups of the country and majority of cases were seen in children younger than 15 years and males were more often affected than females;

WHEREAS, Japanese encephalitis is a significant public health threat, with case fatality rates of up to 30% and long-term neuropsychological sequelaw in 30 to 50% of its survivors;

WHEREAS, there is a need to look in to this matter to prose possible remedial legislation to safeguard the general public;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved, that the Senate of the Philippines directs the Senate Committee on Health and Demography and opther appropriate Senate Committees to conduct an inquiry, in aid of legislation, on the reported cases of Japanese encephalitis in the cordillera region.


WHEREAS, this triumph by the Gilas Pilipinas shows that the Philippines is home to great basketball players, not only in Asia but the world as well;
