**A RESOLUTION
COMMENDING JO GENNA "JUDE" MARTIN JOVER FOR BEING
THE LONE FILIPINO WINNER OF THE N-PEACE AWARDS THIS YEAR**

WHEREAS, Jover, known as Jude among the Teduray, hails from Barangay Timanan in South Upi town, Maguindanao;

WHEREAS, as member of the Kutawato Council for Justice and Peace, Jover has been raising awareness of the rights of indigenous peoples and Moro women;

WHEREAS, she has led consultations with various women groups and also organized trainings to ensure their meaningful participation in governance as well as in peace-building and post-conflict reconstruction;

WHEREAS, Jover also facilitated listening sessions with grassroots Moro communities affected by the decades-long conflict with the government;

WHEREAS, despite the stories of violence and oppression, she remained confident and resolute that peace was achievable and that justice for indigenous peoples could be attained through dialogue and other peace-building methods.

WHEREAS, for her tenacity and passionate work as a peace advocate, she Jover joins this year's roster of winners in the category "Untold Stories: Women Transforming their Communities" of the N-Peace Awards. N-Peace is a multi-country network of peace advocates in Asia initiated by the UN Development Programme seeking to advance women, peace and security issues.
