





REPORT NO. 286

AN ACT CREATING A BARANGAY TO BE KNOWN AS BARANGAY
NORTH SIGNAL VILLAGE IN THE CITY OF TAGUIG, METRO
MANILA

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Philippines in
Congress assembled:*

1 SECTION 1. *Creation of Barangay North Signal Village.* - North
2 Signal Village Proper in Barangay Signal Village, City of Taguig, Metro
3 Manila is hereby separated from Barangay Signal Village and constituted into
4 a distinct and independent barangay to be known as Barangay North Signal
5 Village.

6 SEC. 2. *Territorial Boundaries.* - The territorial boundaries of
7 Barangay North Signal Village shall consist of permanent natural boundaries
8 identified as follows:

9 "Bounded on the North by the property of the Bases Conversion and
10 Development Authority (BCDA-Palacol Area and Pinagsama Village Phase
11 II);

12 On the South by M.R.T. Avenue (formerly Cusay Street);

1 On the East by the property of BCDA (Palakol Area-Pag-asa) and
2 Dream Land Village; and

3 On the West by E.P. Housing Village Phase 2, Sampaloc Street and a
4 creek.”

5 **SEC. 3. *Conduct and Supervision of Plebiscite.*** – The plebiscite
6 conducted and supervised by the Commission on Elections (COMELEC) in
7 Barangay Signal Village pursuant to City Ordinance No. 58, Series of 2008 of
8 the Sangguniang Panlungsod of the City of Taguig, which ratified the creation
9 of Barangay North Signal Village as proclaimed by the City Board of
10 Canvassers on December 28, 2008, shall serve as substantial compliance with
11 the plebiscite requirement under Section 10 of Republic Act No. 7160, as
12 amended, otherwise known as the “Local Government Code of 1991”.

13 **SEC. 4. *Incumbent Barangay Officials.*** – The incumbent barangay
14 officials of Barangay North Signal Village, City of Taguig, Metro Manila shall
15 continue to hold office until such time that their successors have been duly
16 elected and qualified.

17 **SEC. 5. *Public Infrastructures and Facilities.*** – All existing public
18 infrastructures and facilities for public use existing therein at the time of the
19 approval of this Act are hereby transferred without cost or compensation to and
20 shall be administered by the new barangay.

21 **SEC. 6. *Internal Revenue Allotment Shares.*** – Barangay North Signal
22 Village shall be entitled to Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) shares pursuant
23 to Section 285 of Republic Act No. 7160, as amended, otherwise known as the
24 “Local Government Code of 1991”.

25 **SEC. 7. *Separability Clause.*** – If, for any reason, any part or provision
26 of this Act is declared unconstitutional or invalid, the other parts or provisions
27 hereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and
28 effect.

1 SEC. 8. *Effectivity.* – This Act shall take effect fifteen (15) days after
2 its publication in the *Official Gazette* or in any newspaper of general
3 circulation.
